The American Reform Jewish Experience

11th - 12th Grades Anti-Semitism Then and Now / Israel

Tuesdays | 7-8:30 pm BECK FAMILY CAMPUS

A new two-year looping curriculum created in partnership with March of the Living educators from South Palm Beach County, students will spend one year studying the rise of Anti-Semitism leading to the Holocaust until today and the second year they explore Israeli history from 1948 until today. Students who are enrolled in this course and attend the March of the Living trip will automatically receive a \$1000 stipend toward their trip. Starts August 31, 2021

10th Grade Confirmation

Meeting weekly, these students will delve into their own relationships with God, Israel and Judaism with Rabbi Dan Levin. This course culminates in a confirmation ceremony at the end of the year.
