8th Grade Mussar | I Have Your Back Tuesdays | 7-8:30 pm BECK FAMILY CAMPUS Starting 08/30/2022

First Semester - Mussar for Teens: Mussar is a practical and inspiring Jewish spiritual tradition, to foster a life of greater meaning and enhanced relationships. Using the Mussar Institute's curriculum made just for teens we will look at this Jewish spiritual practices that helps us be a better person, one character trait at a time. Second Semester - I Have Your Back 2: Building on I HAVE YOUR BACK, an effort by Rabbi Jessica Mates and her daughter Shira to combat unfair treatment based on gender, we will expand the conversation into the realm of race, anti-Semitism, sexual orientation and bias with guest speakers that have worked to make society better by calling out society's ills. #### 9th Grade The American Reform Jewish Experience Tuesdays 7-8:30 pm BECK FAMILY CAMPUS

#### 11th - 12th Grades Anti-Semitism Then & Now / Israel Tuesdays | 7-8:30 pm BECK FAMILY CAMPUS

A two-year looping curriculum created in partnership with March of the Living educators from South Palm Beach County, students will spend one year studying the rise of Anti-Semitism leading to the Holocaust until today and the second year they explore Israeli history from 1948 until today.
