8th Grade Mussar | I Have Your Back Tuesdays | 7-8:30 pm BECK FAMILY CAMPUS **Starting 08/30/2022**

First Semester – Mussar for Teens: Mussar is a practical and inspiring Jewish spiritual tradition, to foster a life of greater meaning and enhanced relationships. Using the Mussar Institute's curriculum made just for teens we will look at this Jewish spiritual practices that helps us be a better person, one character trait at a time. *Led by Rabbi Jessica Spitalnic Mates*

Second Semester – I Have Your Back 2: Building on I HAVE YOUR BACK, an effort by Rabbi Jessica Mates and her daughter Shira to combat unfair treatment based on gender, we will expand the conversation into the realm of race, anti-Semitism, sexual orientation and bias with guest speakers that have worked to make society better by calling out society's ills. 9th Grade The American Reform Jewish Experience Tuesdays | 7-8:30 pm BECK FAMILY CAMPUS

Reform Judaism is in many ways uniquely American. This course will explore our experience in America, with special attention on our communal life intersecting with Christians, Muslims and Orthodox Jews in our community. We will have a special focus on the uniquenesses of living in South Florida and what opportunities and challenges that presents. *Led by Rabbi Greg Weisman*

10th Grade Confirmation Tuesdays | 7-8:30 pm BECK FAMILY CAMPUS **Starting 08/23/2022**

Meeting weekly, these students will delve into their own relationships with God, Israel and with Judaism. This course culminates in a confirmation ceremony at the end of the year. *Led by Rabbi Dan Levin*

11th - 12th Grades Anti-Semitism Then & Now / Israel Tuesdays | 7-8:30 pm BECK FAMILY CAMPUS **Starting 08/23/2022**

A two-year looping curriculum created in partnership with March of the Living educators from South Palm Beach County, students will spend one year studying the rise of Anti-Semitism leading to the Holocaust until today and the second year they explore Israeli history from 1948 until today. Students who are enrolled in this course and attend the March of the Living trip will automatically receive a \$1000 stipend toward their trip. *Led by teacher, Jason O'Connor*

8th - 12th Grades and parents | Beyachad Teen Removing the Masks We Wear **Starting 08/23/2022**

One Friday and Three Sunday evenings each semester | 7-8:30 pm SCHAEFER FAMILY CAMPUS
